




1. Remove rocks, branches and other sharp objects from the area you will lay on. Spread the shade evenly on the ground.




2. With central hub upright, unfold the poles and lock the joint.




3. Standing behind the shelter, grab the top orange drawstring with one hand and hold the top hub in place with the other.




4. Pull the drawstring firmly till upper and lower parts of the hub connects and the shade takes its shape.



5. Block the mechanism by twisting the orange button, found on the top hub, into "Lock" position.




6. Secure the shade to the beach ground by inserting the included pegs in the appropriate housings at the end of each pole.




7. For extra stability secure the shade to the ground with the outer cords and fill with sand or pebbles the perimetrical outer pockets.




8. For extra privacy or when away from the shelter, ground sheet can be closed by hanging it to the appropriate hooks found on shelter's fabric shell.




1. Remove all the pegs and empty perimetrical pockets.



2. Unlock the mechanism by twisting the orange button, found on the top hub, in to "OPEN" position.



3. Grab with your hand the shelter's structure main black pole and push the orange button with your thumb in order to collapse the shelter.



4. Unlock the joints and fold the poles on themselves.



5. Wreathe exceeding fabric around the mechanism and place the shader in the carry bag.

### Maintenance and storage instructions:

- Only water should be used when cleaning the fabrics.
- The stains should be treated locally and separately.
- The beach shader must be dry and clean before storing.
- Poles and pegs should be stored in their cases.
- Select a dry and shady place to store the beach shade.
